NEW Hollyhock Crimson



Hollyhock Crimson is an outstanding new compact variety of a traditional cottage garden favourite developed with a new generation of gardeners in mind.

Due to its compact size Hollyhock Crimson is the ideal choice for the small space and patio container gardener.

Hollyhock Crimson has a long flowering period and adds high-intensity colour to garden beds, borders and container displays. It may even be used for informal hedges and cut flowers. To promote an abundance of semi-double

to double blooms on multiple strong stems, pinch plants at the fifth or seventh node, and fertilise regularly at recommended rates.

A short-lived perennial frequently treated as an annual Hollyhock will flower 15-17 weeks after planting. Allow an extra two weeks if plants have been pinched. Plant seedlings 30-40cm apart; allow 5-7 plants to the square metre if planting en masse.

NEW Hollyhock Crimson is available in Oasis C Code punnets at nurseries and garden centres from mid-August 2011.
